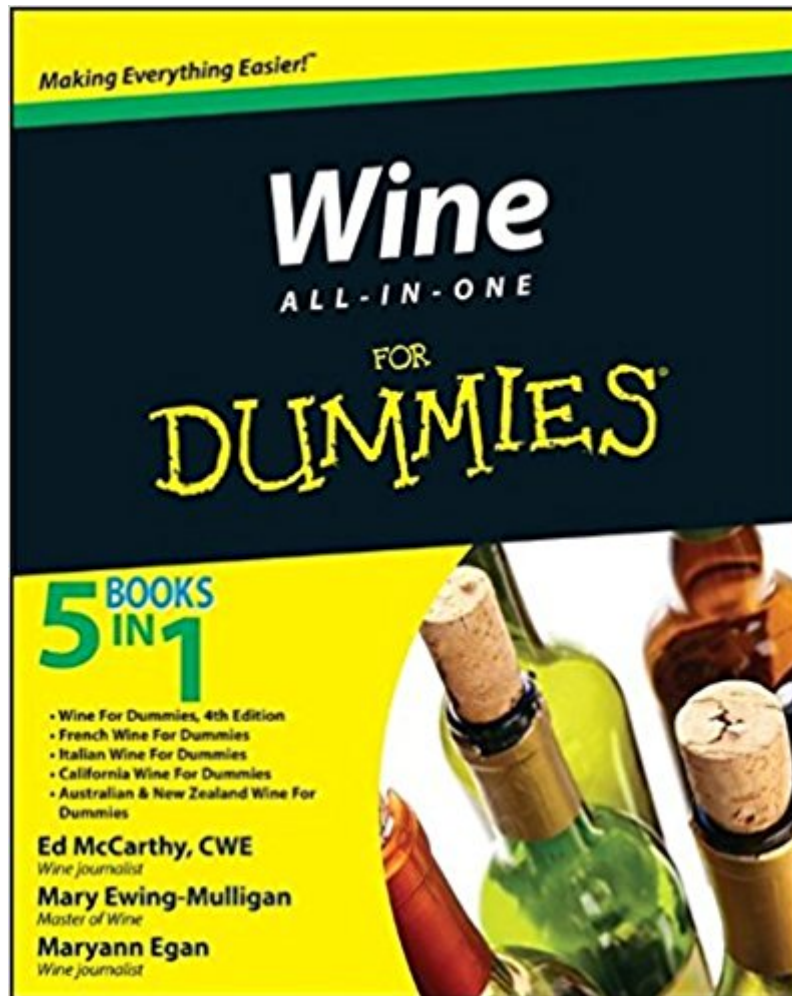

It is quite long, but it is an easy reading and has some very helpful and funny comparisons. Lacks some pictures and beauty (as do all "for dummies" books), but overall has lots of information and even includes suggestions for trying some wines. I would recommend it

I tried to be romantic and gave this to my girlfriend as a gift along with a wine night. She loved it! We did not know anything about wine and the book goes over the basics of everything from the actual making of wine to how to properly drink it. It goes into a lot more depth than I was expecting and I think the book does a great job to set you up into really getting into wines.

Take the statistics with a grain of salt (it's older) and there is some repetition since it's a combined book, but all in all, not a bad starter book for a foundation for more serious study. I read each country's section, then went to the world atlas of wine for the in-depth. a good "pairing", pun intended.....

This is the first "...for dummies" book I've read. The chapters are laid out in such a way that you can easily skip around to find the information you need without having to absorb information that you DON'T need. The tone of the text is informative but casual enough that you shouldn't be bored.
