

Childlike drawings with cleverly used white space and colorful images create suspense leading up to the moment when big sister and baby finally, happily meet. I wanted to find a good big sibling book for our daughter, but I had a really hard time finding any that I liked enough to buy. Most had terrible artwork. Many focus on how boring babies are or how it stinks to get less attention. Many were so focused on teaching a lesson that they do nothing to engage the child. This one, however, was perfect. The artwork is simple and appealing. And, the book focuses on the thoughts and emotions of the child who is waiting for their brother or sister to arrive. The big sister talks about her concern for the baby ("is it dark in there?"), singing to the baby, feeling connected to the baby, and enthusiasm for meeting the baby and sharing her favorite things. And, the flaps that reveal the slowly growing baby on each page are just an added bonus that keep my daughter even more engaged.

We purchased for my 5 year old who was excited to be a big sister. Each page the mom's stomach gets bigger and bigger until they come home with a baby. My daughter started to ask questions about what baby was doing in my stomach and what he would look like because of this book. Great purchase for any expecting big sister.

This is a fantastic book for soon-to-be siblings. Really cute illustrations and story. This is one of my 2 year old's favorite books right now. I like how positive it is towards the arriving baby, and how it builds anticipation.

I like that the little girl in the book is EXCITED about becoming a big sister - sometimes big sibling books emphasize new babies crying and being general bummers for their older sib - this one is sweet and refreshing, in my opinion. :)

I bought this for my 20 month old daughter to start getting her excited for her new baby sister. She loves lifting the flaps to see the little baby in mama's belly. It's really a very sweet book.
