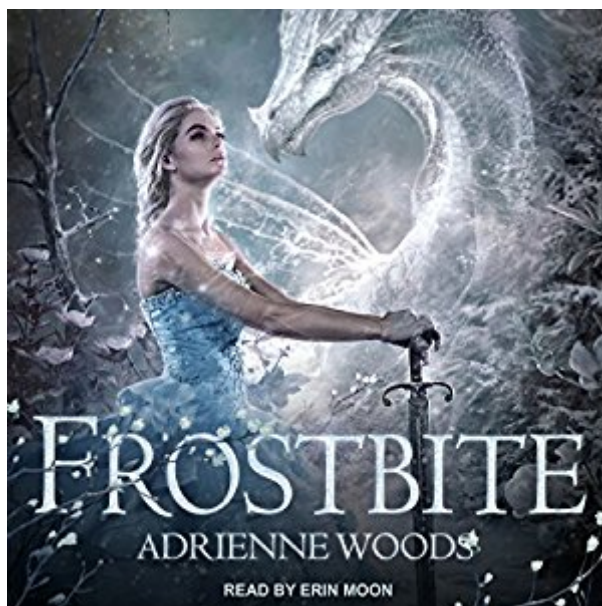

I've been really excited about this series, and the excitement is always at a 5-star rating, but I'm seriously getting annoyed with the lack of errors that a one-time run through would've caught. I'm not even asking for the sentence checks and details, I mean the missing marks and words. This series is a lengthy-type style of writing, and personally, it only works amazingly when the edits aren't kicking me out of the story every time I stumble on an error. It was fine with the first book because it was free, and I overlooked it a bit with the second book, but by the third installment, it honestly should have been fixed. Corrected. Re-advised. I am paying for these books, and I am not the type to pay half a ten-dollar bill for an author I do not know. If I'm going to be paying five bucks, I seriously expected the book to at least be decently edited. Rant aside, I liked the story's plot and Elena having to prove that she is who she says she is. Her dragon, Cara, was an interesting concept, and only added to the mystery of her history. I'm glad it still heavily involves the school and

its traditions, because we finally get to see Elena in all the action. After having lost someone so close to her, and then stumbling upon a new part of her, it's no wonder that she goes a bit crazy. Maybe even a little dark. Her craziness was dragged out a little bit, but I couldn't complain much because it really brought out a lot of other things with the other characters. There were some major reveals that didn't get enough attention, as it'd been such a huge thing to her since the beginning, so that was a bit confusing. Like, what, no ten-page wonder of what she's going through right now? Okay. Towards the end, she got a bit out of hand, but at the same time, because of my assumptions and guesses, I was kind of okay with it. Wasn't exactly fun to watch, but I thought it necessary, that she'll learn from it in the end. I'm obsessed with the first book, and though the series is finally on track of the big picture, I seriously hope it'll be better.

BE SURE TO READ "POISON" NEXT. I enjoy the series quite a bit. All the books need serious editing. There are quite a few typos, some grammatical errors and some very annoying inconsistencies in the story lines. In addition, this novella, "Poison," should be read as book 3.5 in the series. I originally read all 5 and wondered what I had missed. Throughout the series many of the scrapes they get into could have been avoided with better communication. Instead, the teenage protagonist engages in a lot of wrong thinking, and gets into mess after mess. Nonetheless the story is engaging and and worth reading. It's very much for teenagers!

4.5 Stars My favorite book of the series so far. As others have said, a lot of things that many readers have been waiting for are addressed in this book. A few very crucial things that were set up or hinted at in the first two books start paying off, and we meet new characters and get to know more about current ones as a result. The writing has only improved, it contains less filler than the 2nd book did- I liked Lucian well enough but there was too much focus on his & Elena's relationship (which never seemed deep) in Thunderlight (book 2). I wasn't into that romance because it was obvious from the start which guy (or should I say dragon) Elena is meant to be with. I feel like this is definitely the best book for Elena as a character, as well. She is no longer the same girl she was when dropped into this world. She has a lot of new struggles to overcome, including getting a taste of something Blake has had to deal with for years. Although this series has definitely had many twists, what I love about it is it's not out to mess with its readers by doing things that don't make sense, only to shock people. Everything is set up well and hinted at in at least subtle ways and you know you'll eventually get there, but not how you'll get there, which makes it exciting. It's much harder to write that way than it is to simply do anything for the sake of being unpredictable, so big

compliments to the author. I flew through this third book in a couple days and can't wait until the fourth book (Moonbreeze) comes out.

Just like the first two books in the series, this one was jam packed with adventure, danger, romance, and heart pounding mysteries and surprises! Elena's story line twist was predictable yet unpredictable. Adrienne portrayed Elena's pain from the loss of Lucian extremely well, and allowed Blake's essence, his anger, his hatred, and his darkness, to shine through her just as it should have. I am devouring this series and loving every minute of it!

Another great book in series on to the next one. Excellent writing and awesome story line. You will enjoy this series I guarantee serious, fun, sad and exciting.
