

It is a repackaging of some of Ramit's best content from his blog, but the content is still great information and very helpful for people who are looking to start a business or even just thinking about starting a business. Plus it's all in one place which is much easier than trying to dig through the blog. To me, the book is an introduction to building a business and can definitely get you started on your journey. Some of my favorite lessons include how to find a profitable business idea. Which includes questions to ask yourself. One question in particular was helpful for me "What do you do on a Saturday morning before everyone else is awake?" How to test for demand of the business you want to build. How to do real market research for your products so that the people you want to serve feel like you've created your products just for them. The 3 simple mindset shifts that will help you conquer your fear of starting a business. These are just a few of the lessons in the book that are all great and informative. I also really enjoyed the bonus content that you get from the book. The video's email scripts, and information provided is very helpful. I was able to read this book in one sitting - it's just that great. Ramit is great at simplifying concepts and really explaining them on a human level that goes beyond "hey you should be doing this!" to "this is why I think it would be a great idea to do this". It comes from a place of teaching rather than "I'm an expert, so you need to listen." There's a lot in this book to learn and implement that one can't possibly just read this once and put this book away. You'll need to come back to it over and over. Even if not just for the tactics but for the recalibration of your mindset and psychology. By reading this book, you'll be able to immediately take one idea from this book to implement that will help you earn more money tomorrow - such as focusing on writing better copy for my website and marketing material. This may seem small, but honestly, I haven't seen many entrepreneurs focus on this. The ones that are focused on understanding how to write better copy are excelling in their industries. I would recommend this book for any entrepreneur that's making 6-figures or less.

If you're looking to build a business, you can read any other online business book. If you're looking to build a business with integrity that will position you as a top influencer in your niche, make you money, and make you feel good doing it, then Ramit's your guy. His no-nonsense approach and proven methods are hard to ignore, and are both inspirational and aspirational. His advice makes me excited to take action but also holds me accountable when I don't.
