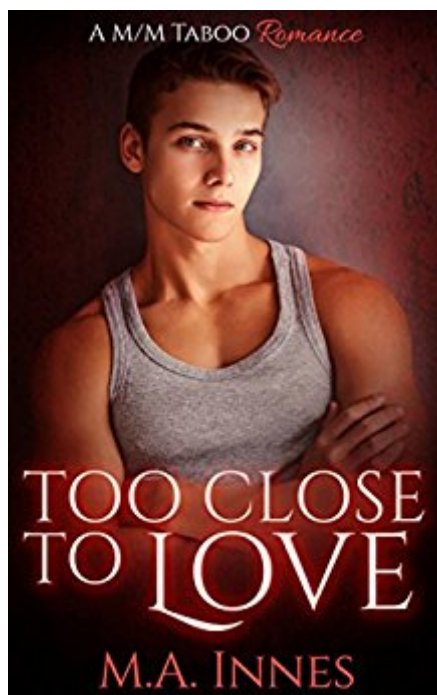

This is my first book by this author and didn't know what to expect. She turned a story about incest into a beautiful love story. I can't wait for the next book

Oh my gosh. I liked this book so much more than I even thought I would. This author did an amazing job! We first encounter Kevin when he is 14 and endures some trauma. Jeremy is his big

brother who has always had Kevin's back. And in turn, Kevin has a bit of hero-worship going on. After the trauma, things change for the brothers. They grow even closer. It's the skill of the author that makes you believe this; it's SO well done! Kevin and Jeremy are both quite tentative because they aren't sure what the other thinks. This is a very slow build-up but it's so hot!! I was kind of on the edge of my seat the whole time I was reading because there is some tension. I kept thinking, "Oh, please, please don't rip these two apart!" So there was that emotion. And then there was the happiness I felt because Jeremy was SMART. He was always a planner, and plan well is what he did. I loved that. I know I'm not really supposed to love that these two ended up together but I do. And I will be looking for the next book that continues the story of Kevin and Jeremy. Five slow-burning, emotionally ramped up stars!

This was a taboo subject matter, very carefully and beautifully written....For the most part it was about the feelings Kevin and Jeremy as brothers were developing for each other, after a very traumatic experience, what started out as feeling scared and needing to protect, over time became all consuming for both boys. Both Kevin and Jeremy were really stressing out over their love for each other, and what to do next. Their parents were scared/worried and understandably reacted badly, which made the boys want to run away and live on their own as a couple. I felt the author made sure not to over sensationalise the subject matter, which made for a very enjoyable read with enough tender and "OMG" moments. This is basically a story about a guy who loves another so much that he wants to protect him from anyone and anything that could hurt him. Sadly, that includes their parents, who don't even begin to try to understand or accept them. The background of one of the boys having a narrow escape when he was younger explains a lot about the protectiveness of the other. Their closeness is understandable, and as it slowly grows to more, they are both uncertain about how the other feels. It's sweet to see it play out, and then when they finally are at a point where they can be open with each other, it is SO sexy. Their chemistry is amazing, and their love for each other is clear. Definitely a series I will continue to read.
