I could not put this down once I started reading, yet did not want the book to end! I think if another author had switched the narrator from chapter to chapter I would have been irked. If my reading was interrupted I would have to double-check, but I really enjoyed getting into the different characters point of view. I am halfway through *Daughter of Time*,<sup>Â</sup> *Daughter of Time: A Time Travel Romance* (The After Cilmeri Series)<sup>Â</sup> the other book in this series and I would recommend reading that one first, then these two. I plan on reading everything Sarah Woodbury puts out, and I would most like to revisit her series if and when they come out on audiobook.

I normally don't like to read books where the same characters are featured book after book, NY not to is "one couple, one book" but I'm making an exception for this series and I'm reading it for the second time. In book one which was before these stories Meg had gone back to the thirteenth century with her young daughter Anna and fallen in love with the prince of Wales and became pregnant with his baby before being transported back to the twentieth century. It's now 15 years later and that baby and his older sister are transported back to the thirteenth century just in time to save the Prince's life which doesn't happen in the twentieth century history books, what else is going to be changed by this new history? The second story in the book David, who now knows he is a Prince of Wales, is on the run from a band of English soldiers when one of his guards is shot with an arrow, it's obvious he will be caught and his friends injury could be fatal so hoping he's right about how the time transporting works, he jumps off a cliff and ends up in twentieth century Pennsylvania. They meet Bronwyn who is a masters archaeology student who has just lost her tuition funding and has nothing to lose. Together they gather useful twentieth century items to bring with them and again travel to the thirteenth century to kick some English butt. I'm loving this series and can't wait to see what will happen next

I read *Daughter of Time*, but got distracted before I purchased the next book. I bought this set featuring the first and second books, *Footsteps in Time/Prince of Time*. I love this series because it not only feature excellent history and geography of the fascinating country of Wales, but continues the alternate history built on real knowledge of the customs and social climate of the time. I loved the fact that Longshanks was killed off in this alternate history and what that would have meant to history. I loved the characters of Anna, David, Meg and Llywelyn. This is a family saga that builds an alternate history from the premise that Llywelyn, the last Prince of Wales, was saved from assassination and is joined by the son he conceived with Meg in *Daughter of Time* and his sister Anna. The changes made in medieval Wales by 21st century teenagers forced to grow up quickly to

survive their new circumstances. The characters are well drawn. This is an epic adventure that includes romance but is not focused on it. I am looking forward to the next five books in this series.

I started this series with the free prequel: Daughter of Time. I am glad that I read it first rather than in the order in which the books were written. I would recommend others doing the same. I have really enjoyed this time-travelling series and have read them all--hoping that this is not the end of the stories involving these characters. I did have to buy the last two books in paperback at \$14 each. I was willing to do so because I enjoyed the others so much. I like that they have historical characters, but are fiction. I like the blending of American and Welsh ways and messages conveyed about marriage, love, honor, and loyalty.

I downloaded "Daughter of Time" on my kindle as a free book and was pleasantly surprised at how quickly it drew me in! I couldn't stop reading! So naturally I purchased the bundle with "Footsteps in Time" and "Prince of Time"! I'm loving every word and can't wait to download "Crossroads in Time". These are very well written and have a perfect blend of time travel, fantasy, romance, and even humor. LOVE THEM!

The author tells the story by switching between characters, allowing the reader to see it from different points of view. Normally, I find this can be annoying, but this author does it well. There are no dull moments, with twists in the plot to keep you reading. Highly recommended to those who love history, time travel stories, or action.
