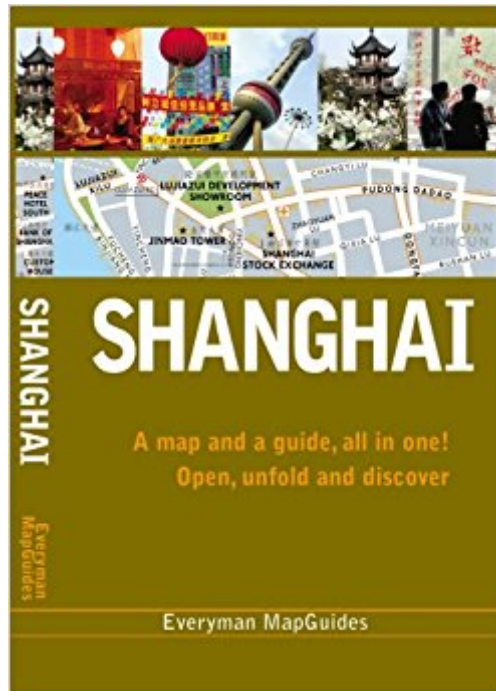

After struggling with sub-standard maps for several months as an expatriate living in the Shanghai area, I finally discovered this one. This is by far the best of all the Shanghai maps I have. It is clear to read, easy to search, a good portable size, and I have yet to find an inaccuracy. The booklet divides the city into sections, each with a sturdy fold up map of that area (you don't have to mess with awkward oversized maps when all you need is to see one neighborhood). Minor streets are marked and well indexed. It also includes a very good subway route map. I now plan to buy one every time I visit a major city.

This book is perfect for people that like to roam around neighborhoods. The descriptions of various monuments are concise. The book takes each area of Shanghai and creates a fold out map of two pages. This is incredibly convenient to use when you're navigating the throngs of people in the busy streets.

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
