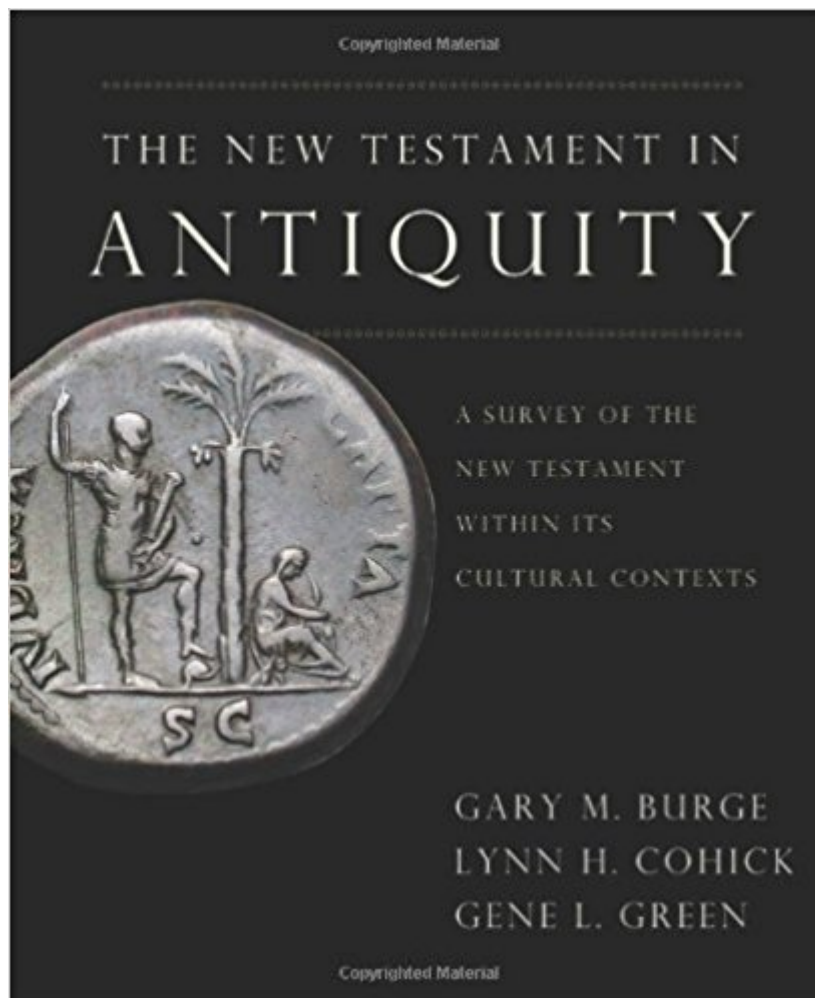

Kindle version has so many errors that it is distracting. I would give this book five stars, but part of delivering a good product, especially when it comes to books, is to make a good presentation of the material. or the publisher should not charge almost full print price for the Kindle version, then do such a poor job in its formatting. It's not just an occasional error, either. Words or letters are chopped off, seemingly as part of an editing attempt, then the extra letters and chopped off words are added back in rather randomly. I'd rather not have to slow my reading time with these distractions.

This book was pretty interesting. It has a lot of good information for anyone who is just starting to learn about the New Testament. I really enjoyed the extra pieces they put in the margins that just shared a little more about the culture and history or gave background to specific people mentioned in the text. My one complaint is that it would often direct me to "see text box above" or below or to the side, and there would be no text box there. Sometimes what it was referring to would be on a different page or couldn't be found at all.
