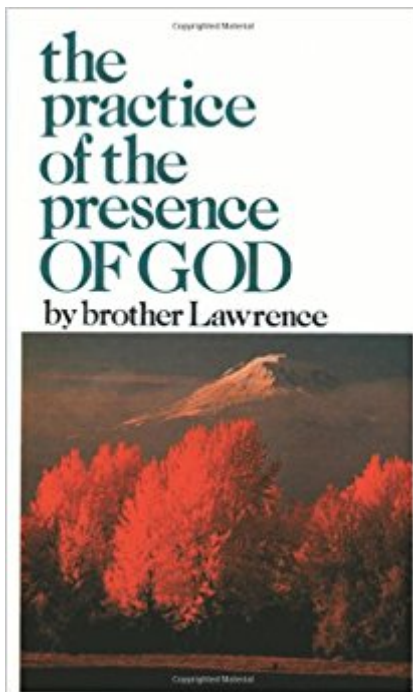

This is a classic that I hadn't read before. But I'm glad that I read it now. Brother Lawrence doesn't advocate anything that is complicated, which I believe we too often try to make being in God's presence. Instead, there's a beauty in the simplicity of the practices he advocates. It's not a long read, but it's definitely good.

Brother Lawrence of the Resurrection, a saint whether he is recognized as being one or not, practiced the "Little Way" of Therese of Lisieux two hundred years before she was born. This is evident once his words and hers are read and compared. How did I come across this book? I received a phone call from my sister, and she said that she had been starting her day with a cup of coffee when God told her to phone me and tell me about some man named Lawrence who was a dishwasher but had royalty visit him constantly so he could lead them to Christ.
