

Wild at Heart laid down the love affair in the midst of a war zone idea and posed the questions of a man within that construct? We regained the perspective of ourselves in God's eyes. Fathered by God personalizes the relationship with God in a way which makes His presence palpable, imminent and intimate - it illustrates how God cares as a father to be with and raise His sons, to give their reality the assurance, peacefulness and joy of Him being there. This helps a man lay aside chains and encumbrances of the past in order to heal and walk with a well intentioned, friendly and loving Father. Although we read of God the Father, our perspective of this person of the Godhead often suffers damage from our own father son experiences as well as a lot of over emphasis on power rather than love-adventure-goodness in the teaching of western Christendom. We get a piece of the relationship between our Father and our older brother Jesus. This book helps restore our imagination of our Father and give us confidence in His intentionality and passionate care and love of His sons.

It breaks down a man's life journey and make you think of how your own personal journey is going. Did I miss something, what is my heart desiring, am I really doing this for the right reason?

First of all, I'm a fan of John Eldredge's writing and thought. I've read several of his books and have enjoyed and been enriched by every one that I've read. I have read this particular book three times

and will likely read it more as my own son grows and his needs change. I am a school psychologist by trade and work almost exclusively with teens. John's book helped me understand the masculine journey at a deeper and more pragmatic level than the other books I've read on this topic. The stages of adored son, cowboy, warrior, lover, king and sage are simple to understand. Once the stages are understood, intentional habits can be created to meet the needs of each stage. Though the concepts are simple, living them calls for a high level of intentionality, self sacrifice and uplifting others, which is much of what it means to be a man living in God's kingdom. I have had my heart melted, smacked and strengthened by the truth in John's book. Highly recommended!

In this book, John Eldridge hits the nail right on the head regarding the principles and total mindset that so many men have just never really been exposed to, fully embraced, and/or put into action. After reading this book, I feel really inspired and equipped to live in and out of a full identity as a son of God who knows the way of His Father.

Only Heavenly Father loves us completely just as we are. If we grew up with a father who did not know how to love us and verbally and physically abused us then it is difficult to believe that God loves us and to trust him.
