

My class loves to "make words"! It starts off with easy words that elicited groans, but they soon realized that the words became more sophisticated! I love the word wall template, which I made into a poster at school to record our words. Wish I had bought it in September! Will definitely start off next year using it!

This was recommended to me by a reading specialist for use in my special education classroom. It provides practice for phonics and spelling, and it can be used by regular education elementary teachers, as well as, middle school special education teachers for teaching learning disabled students. I have used this in my classroom of middle school students, and they are ALL engaged. The activities are short and fast moving. They are inexpensive to reproduce, and the activities are scripted so they require very little planning and preparation.
