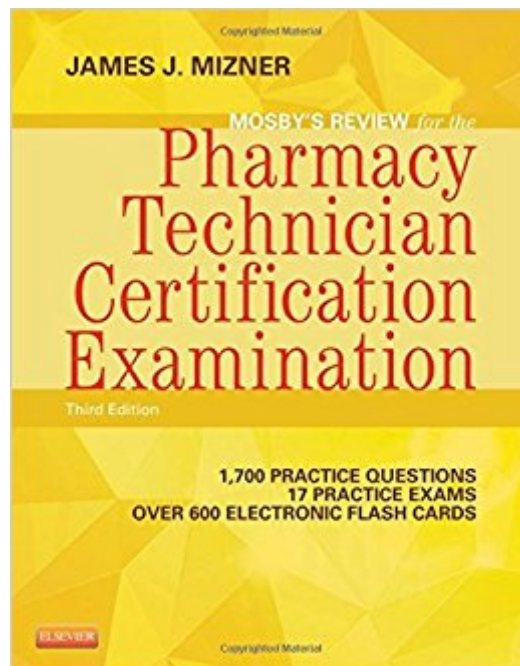

If you're planning on taking the PTCB this book is the best study guide you will ever need! Of course I also went to school, but this book even had actual questions from the test in it, and I passed with flying color. If you can't afford the book by itself, they have an online book that has tons of quizzes and goodies.

My boyfriend took a Pharmacy Technician course over the summer. When he took a practice exam, he realized that the teacher taught them nothing that pertains to the certification exam and the book the class gave him was full of jargon. I got him this book due to all the great reviews. He studied with only this book for two weeks and passed.

This book provides a framework of words whose definition you often need to look up/find from other sources. Reading this has prompted me to purchase books on anatomy as well as purchase a pharmacy index so I can find out what this book is talking about. Ideally these things would be defined within the book, complete with clear diagrams in the case of anatomy. However, at least it has the framework of things to look up and learn. I feel that if I master this book completely and accurately that I will be able to pass the Pharmacy Technician Certification Examination.

Rented this book, as I had let my PTCP certification lapse a couple years ago, but my new job just began to require PTCB certification. Tips for folks renewing: Take a practice test, and study from this book the 'knowledge domains' that you score lowest in.

Purchased this book to use as the basis for my online pharmacy technician course. Covers all sections of the pharmacy technician certification board test with the exception of calculations. A must buy for anyone looking to study for the test.

This textbook is riddled with incorrect information regarding pharmacy practices and laws. Many answers in the back of the book don't match up with the options for each chapter quiz and some answers are plain *wrong*... but there is no way for some people to know if they haven't been in pharmacy for a while! I have been a retail tech for 6 years and am confident in my knowledge of pharmacy practices and I do not recommend this for anyone looking to study for their certification exam.

This has a lot of questions related to the PTCB test. I passed the test recently but I'm not sure if this book helped me that much. The questions seem to be phrased like the test would.
