I'm only part-way through, but this short book is easily the best nursing text I have ever read. Full of humor, biting accurate commentary (the section on "supernurse" had me laughing out loud) and practical advice/wisdom, in its few pages it will give you a better view of home health nursing than thousand page traditional text books full of empty platitudes written in "nurse-ese". Well worth the price. I hope the author writes more. My only complaint is that it wasn't ten times longer.

If I find just one bit of info, that can help me do my job better and ultimately keep my patients safe it means so much to me. This book is FILLED with tips and useful insights.
