

There are multiple views of Crater Lake itself, with its deep blue waters and unique islands; the surrounding peaks, forests, and flowers; and the locals: foxes, martens, bear and deer. Included are some nice shots of the magnificent old inn on the south rim and the road that winds around the rim of the crater.
