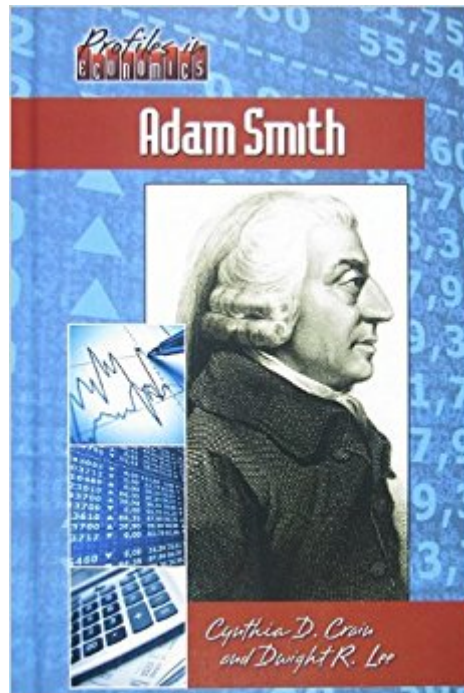

Relationships, education, early influences, and family life are all described, creating fairly complete pictures of the individuals. Economic theory is closely tied to cultural and political events, and the authors make every effort to highlight how these differing influences impacted both the theorist and the idea. While the other books are generally positive, Marx is negative, both about the man's theories on socialism and regarding his personal life.
