

Leen and Kathleen Ritmeyer met in 1975 on the Temple Mount excavations in Jerusalem. Dr Leen Ritmeyer's holds a doctorate from the University of Manchester, England, the subject of his dissertation being: "The Architectural Development of the Temple Mount in Jerusalem"

If you're at all interested in understanding the Temple Mount in Jerusalem (and especially if you're planning a visit), this is an essential resource for you. I just finished reading it in preparation for a trip to Jerusalem in early February, and this book has me totally pumped up for the Temple Mount tour. I'm a Biblical archaeology aficionado, and have been reading about archaeological digs in Jerusalem and studying the theories about the Temple Mount for over two decades, so this isn't a new topic for me. The Ritmeyer's book has opened up this topic to me in ways that I've never gotten from the many articles that I've read, however. The comprehensive review of both the exterior of the Temple Mount walls and its interior environs is presented in a systematic way, with many photos and annotated illustrations, such that I feel that I have gained, for the first time, an integrated understanding of all the structures and historical layers of the Temple Mount. Beyond that, the Ritmeyers write in such an accessible style that you don't have to have any background in this topic

at all to get valuable insights and understanding of how the Temple Mount came to be and its importance to the people of Jerusalem over the past three millennia. Note that this book includes a Glossary of Archaeological and Architectural terms, so if you encounter a technical word with which you're unfamiliar, the Glossary will define it for you (and, if needed, show you a relevant illustration). There are detailed maps, illustrations, and color photos throughout the book that fully illuminate the text. Three appendices provided annotated maps that review much of information about the contemporary structures and features of the Temple Mount--one also provides links to from specific sites to various Bible passages from the Gospels and Acts. Finally, there is a detailed index that will allow you to use this as an accessible reference manual during your tour (or during any future study you may make that involves the Temple and its environs). I can't recommend this book highly enough!
