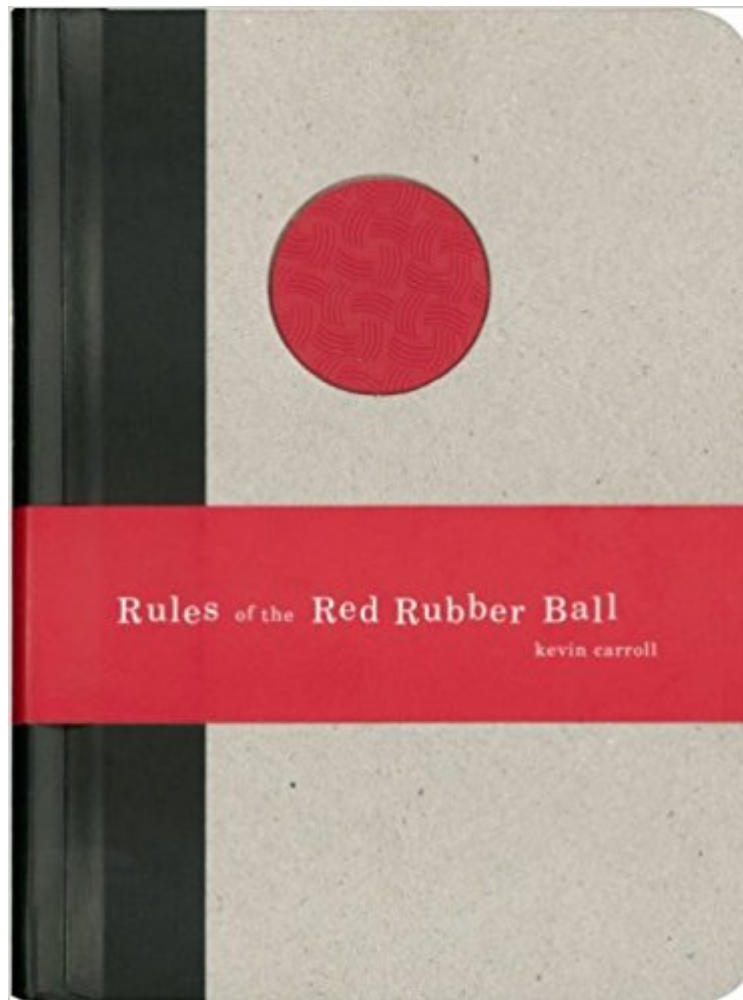




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Rules Of The Red Rubber Ball: Find And Sustain Your Life's Work

Caroll's message is great, and no one can argue that this book isn't inspirational. However, I do feel it gives unhealthy ideas too. For example, Caroll reported that to get through school, he worked entire nights and only slept during 2 short naps in a 24 hour period, every single day. That's unhealthy, not motivating. Yes, you should work to make your passion reality, but for goodness sake, do it the healthy way with lots of sleep, good food, and exercise. Besides that, it's a small book, so there's really only mostly positive information in it. There is no help section for if things go wrong, and there is no section on friends/family/people you love helping you succeed either. I would advise taking this book in the same way you regard those little calendars with inspirational sayings; acknowledge it, work toward it, but realize that constant happiness with what you're doing in life isn't always feasible. Instead, focus on being content.

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
