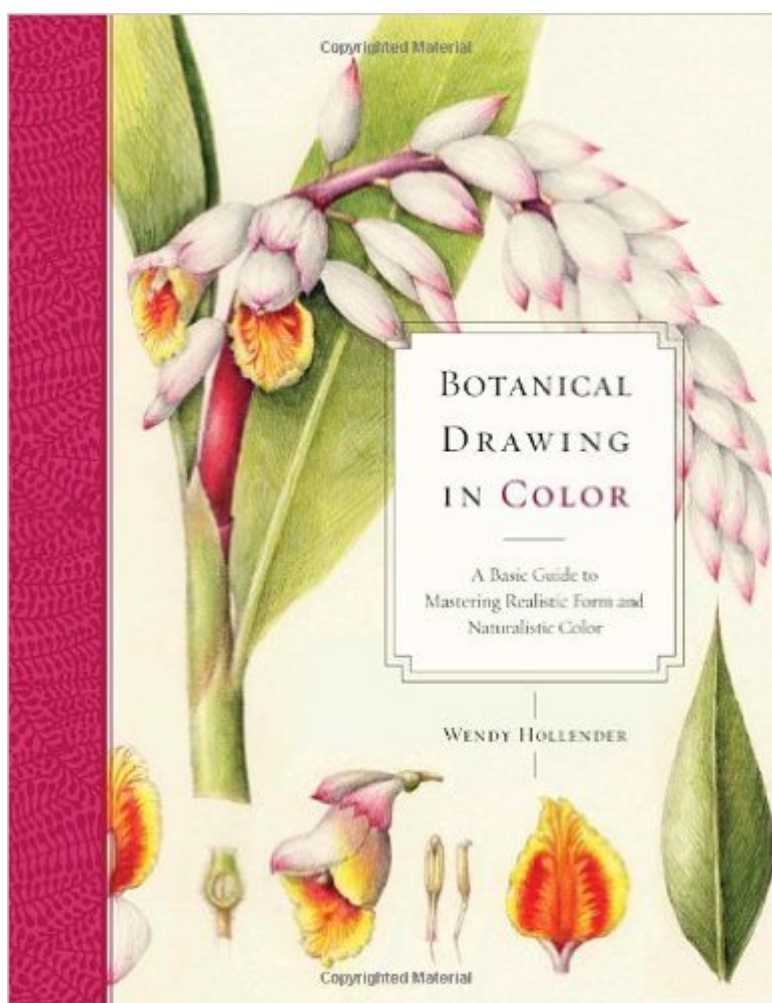

Her work has been featured in the prestigious Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation's 13th International Exhibition of Botanical Art & Illustration at Carnegie Mellon University. She is the founder of WH Art & Design and a member of the American Society of Botanical Artists, the Guild of Natural Science Illustrators, the Brooklyn Botanic Garden Florilegium, and the New York Botanical Garden Board of Advisors.

This is a book that many of us who do Botanical Illustration in colored pencil have been waiting for—a real workbook for the pencil artist. Wendy is an experienced teacher and provides simple, clear

lessons not only on colored pencil techniques but on basic nature drawing and creating form. There is also a good section on color theory. The book is packed with delicious colored illustrations of a variety of plants and fruits some wonderfully exotic. I was inspired by her section on dissections and creating compositions showing the reproductive parts of plants. The book is a great teaching tool with lots of step by step exercises. It is definitely very inspiring for the beginning artist and the experienced painter.

A beautiful book that gives a lot of good information on botanical drawing with colored pencils. There are very detailed lessons for one to follow that are as good or even better than attending a class. Beginners and more advanced artists alike can appreciate the drawing exercises, the exploration of color theory and the techniques for mastering drawing with colored pencils.
