

This lavishly illustrated history of the NFL's Colts celebrates an iconic franchise from its origins to the present day. With an era of great success in Baltimore from 1950 to 1983, the Colts

established themselves early on as one of the league's premier teams. Fielding Pro Football Hall of Famers such as Johnny Unitas, Raymond Berry, John Mackey, Gino Marchetti, and Lenny Moore, the Colts became part of the fabric of the city and the team's eventual decision to leave Baltimore dealt a major blow to NFL fans in the area. Since the move to Indianapolis in 1984, the Colts have reclaimed greatness in their "new" home. In fact, 1960-1966, are all incorrect and they just reprinted 1953-1959 stats as 1960-1966! Not to nitpick, but how can any Colt fan who loves the history of team horseshoe not notice this? A team with Johnny Unitas, Raymond Berry, Jim Parker, Lenny Moore, Gino Machetti, & Bob Boyd, going 3-9 two years in a row, I don't think so.
