

This has now become one of my favorite science book series. It is not as dense a read as Wheater's Atlas, and is actually quite enjoyable to read. It is an excellent explanatory introduction into the theories and basics of histology in a very clear and concise manner. I would compare it to the Lippincott's Biochemistry text. It explains the theory and shows slides and pictures to help illustrate the material. I would highly recommend this book to any medical student before their histology class, or any pre-med looking to get a head start into a deeper understanding of the human body's cells and how they work.
