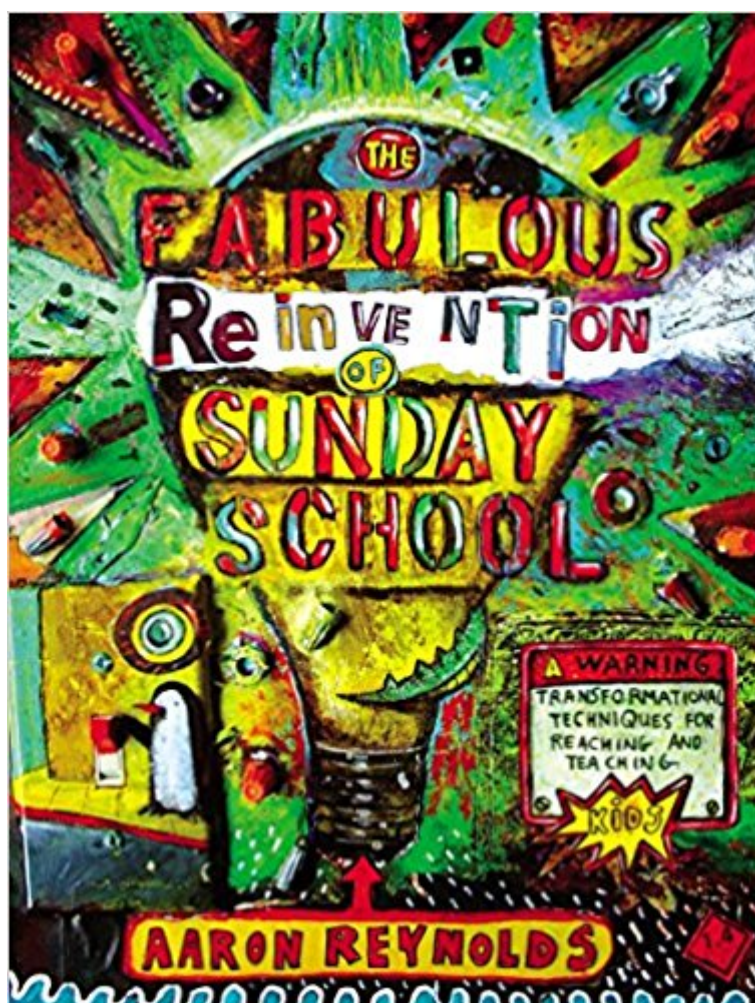

To me that is the mark of a good "how to" book. The help I picked up was not dated, but some of what I am reading is dated, so I do not know if this book will stand the test of time. What may date it is that the author bases his teaching on the type of curriculum he is using in his church. He uses a large group/small group type that requires a teaching team. However, I found that I could still extract the principles and apply them to the method of teaching I use in our "one room school house" situation (which is small group/small group). For the time being, even though it was published 7 years ago, there is still enough in here to make it helpful. I found Part 1, "Creating an Atmosphere of Excellence," very challenging and motivational. Part 1 is well done.
