

Isaac Bashevis Singer—one of the greatest story-tellers of all time—opens this sparkling series of eight Chanukah stories with a reminiscence from his own childhood in his parents' house. He recalls once evening, the last night of the festival of lights when his father, a rabbi in Warsaw, allowed his children to play the Chanukah game of dreidel. On this occasion, it was snowing, and his brother Joshua pointed out that each snowflake was a hexagon—it had six sides "with fancy little designs and decorations." His father added that it was the world of God Almighty. The story then explains how the game of dreidel works, right down to the meaning of the letters on the little top. And it imparts the story of a miracle contemporary to his father's time. All eight other stories, including the title piece about Chanukah during the Nazi era, are miracles in their own right.—Alyssa A. Lappen
