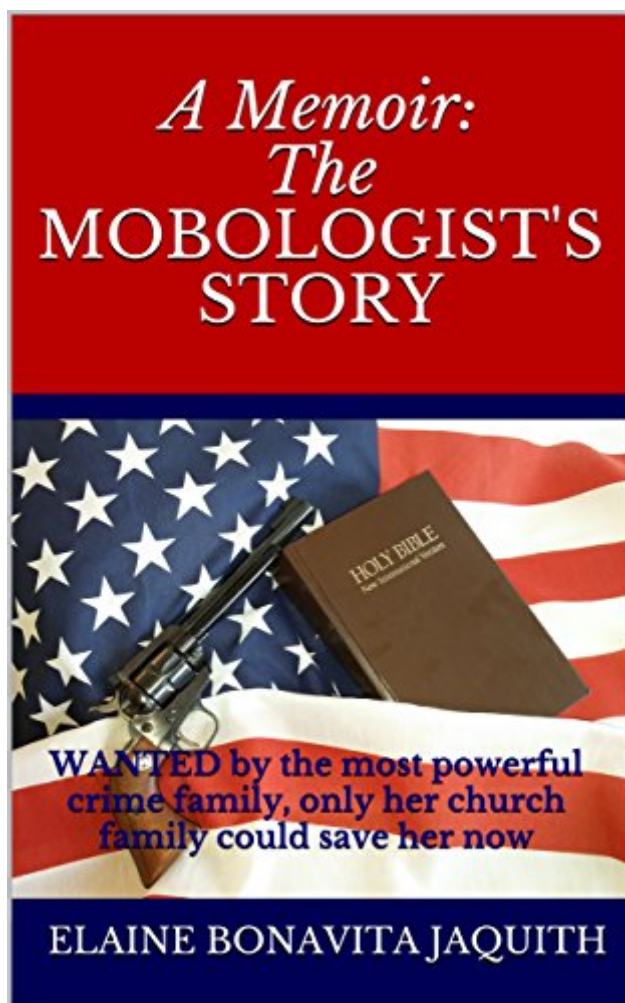

## Synopsis

Before she knows it, she is pregnant with the out-of-wedlock son of a boxer turned mafia bodyguard named "Big Al." It's only when Skyball's Springfield crew plots the murder of a witness to his son-in-law's mob murder in Agawam, that the author's father gets involved, doing the unthinkable when he learns the witness is his own daughter. Instead of trying to get her into a witness protection program, her ever loyal mafia father brokers a deal with the Springfield mob's boss, exiling her to Texas in exchange for her silence. Unable to keep her word to stay away, she yearns to go home and returns to Agawam only to find herself face to face with the very same crime family she had run away from just six years earlier. Instead of running, she chooses to stand and fight them by winning a seat on the Town Council at the side of the not-so-known "Godfather" of the Agawam faction. It's what her father secretly does to keep her safe again, that backfires, bringing her into a world of bribes, threats and murder in a town held hostage: Agawam, Massachusetts. Only her new Mormon church family can save her.
