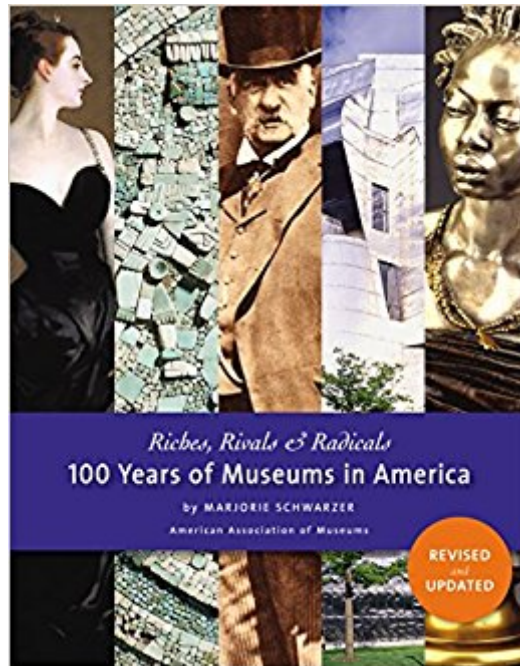




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Riches, Rivals And Radicals: 100 Years Of Museums In America
