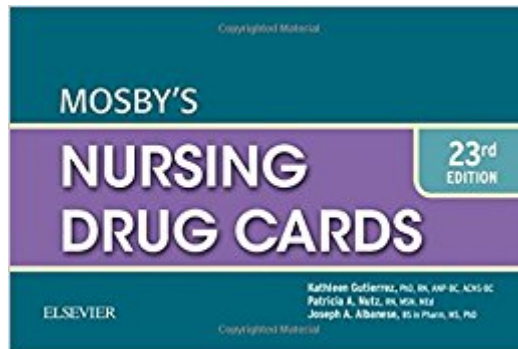




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Mosby's Nursing Drug Cards, 23e

Portable 4x6-inch cards are smaller than most drug cards and fit easily into a pocket. Consistent format features a drug's generic name, pronunciation, category, pregnancy category, brand name, dosage forms, use, action, pharmacokinetics, side/adverse effects, contraindications, interactions, dosage, and nursing management priorities. Black Box Warnings highlight high-alert drugs. Nursing management priorities follow a nursing process format: assess, diagnose, implement, and evaluate. Drug side effects information distinguishes between common and life-threatening side effects for drugs. NANDA-I approved nursing diagnoses for all drug categories show the application of nursing diagnoses in pharmacology. Information on nutritional supplements found in the appendix includes information on both herbal and non-herbal supplements. Drug interaction information includes subheadings for drug, food, and laboratory interactions. Drug pronunciations are listed for each generic drug and drug category. Common conversion formulas are found on the inside lid of the box. Dosage calculation formulas are listed in the appendix. Blank card template lets you create additional cards.

The "cards" are printed on pulp paper, making them absorbent of any fluids, such as blood, snot, or vomit. I used a ziplock bag to keep them dry and protected when not in use in my scrub pocket.

There were also a number of medications not included in the deck, but the cards are the same size as large note cards, making it a pretty simple process of inserting your own handmade cards without having size discrepancies. The information contained on the cards is concise and effective, making it a good supplementation for making handmade cards for medication passing. The most annoying thing is that some meds have too much info, and have a second card with only a few sentences on it. I copied the info from the second card into the margin of the first, and threw the second one away.

They were very helpful in reducing my time of making drug cards for my med pass. The cards had a bit more info than I actually needed for the assignment. But they are very good drug cards and I would recommend them if you are in nursing school with small children and don't have a lot of time to stay up all night researching meds. Hope this helps!

For \$40 these are not what I expected! First off it's just a box filled with the pages of a drug guide made into flimsy, unlaminated cards. They are not separated into which system they act on and although they are in alphabetical order there's no tabs that make it easier to find them. A real pain is that the information is not even condensed onto one card. This is probably one of the biggest disappointments I have received off of . Buy something else that is less expensive and put together in a much better way.

These were a last minute buy for me. I am in my last semester of school and thought these would be helpful to study with. They have not been for me. A lot of the drugs we are covering are not in there. I could see how this would of been helpful if I bought them at the beginning of my schooling!

Short and sweet on the information. They worked well for clinical. Still needed to add a post it note to personalize it to my patient, but that was easier than having to write a card from scratch.

Covers drugs in detail on each card. Had almost all the drugs in it that I needed to look up. Perfect for nursing school! Only problem was some of the cards came out of order.

I love these cards! They were very helpful for my first semester of nursing school. We had numerous simulation labs where we needed to fill out drug cards, but by purchasing these cards it eliminated a lot of extra time writing out cards.

The mosby cards are good. I am using them for my nursing degree. A classmate ordered the mediquick cards and hers had more of the medication cards than these did. But these are great size and fit well in my scrub pocket.

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
